

RESOLUTION NO. 720

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES REGARD-
ING THE ADVISABILITY OF HAVING CAMP ROBERTS DECLAR-
ED A PERMANENT MILITARY RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Camp Roberts is again reactivated as
a Military Reservation and training center; and

WHEREAS, The Military Reservation consists of
ideal and varied terrain for the training of troops and
is suitable for training soldiers in all arms and
branches of service; and

WHEREAS, Camp Roberts is centrally located
midway between the City of Los Angeles and the City of
San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles requests
that consideration be given to declaring Camp Roberts a
permanent Military Reservation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED
BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES as
follows:

1. That for the foregoing reasons, it is de-
sirable that Camp Roberts be recognized as a permanent
Military Reservation.


2. That if Camp Roberts is declared to be a
permanent Military Reservation, this would be a great
incentive to the construction of needed housing in the
Paso Robles and Camp Roberts area.

3. That a certified copy of this Resolution
be forwarded to the Department of the Army through the
Headquarters of the Sixth Army at the Presidio in San
Francisco, California, and further certified copies of

this Resolution be forwarded to California Senators, Knowland and Nixon, and to Congressman Bramblett.

PASSED AND ADOPTED this 5th day of February, 1951, by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles.
