

RESOLUTION NO. 740

REQUESTING CANCELLATION OF COUNTY TAXES
ON CITY OWNED PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles did by a deed dated March 29, 1950, and recorded May 25, 1950, in Volume 566 at Page 25 of the Official Records of the County of San Luis Obispo, acquire the property hereinafter described from Charles A. Brooner and Dorothy P. Brooner:


Lots 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 in Block 141 as shown on the Official Map of the City of El Paso de Robles, filed in the office of the County Recorder, San Luis Obispo County, State of California on October 25, 1889.

WHEREAS, said property was assessed on the 1950-51 San Luis Obispo County Tax Rolls as a lien not yet due and payable at the time of purchase, and

WHEREAS, said property was acquired by the City of El Paso de Robles for public street purposes and because of this public ownership is not subject to county taxes;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles be and he is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo as a request to order the Tax Collector of the County of San Luis Obispo to cancel all uncollected taxes, penalties and costs heretofore levied on the above described property.
