PARCEL #1: That part of Lot 15 of Rancho Santa Ysabel
as surveyed and platted by R. R. Harris in October 1886,
and filed for record at page 29 of Book "A" in the San
Luis Obispo County Recorder's Office, said part of Lot
15 being more particularly described as follows:
Commencing at point SY 111 in the center line of
Creston Road, being former County Road No. 91, and
running thence South 85° 25' West 817.08 feet along
said center line to a point; thence leaving said line
and running South to a point; thence running North 46' true
point of beginning; thence running North 46' East
239.13 feet to a point; thence running North 48'
35" East 81.90 feet for a distance of 790' Easterly,
46' 14' 30" East for a course which bears an angle
of 26' East having a radius of 28.50 feet to a
point; 04' 45" thence leaving said curve through
former County Road No. 91 along the Southerly line of
thence running North 40' 04' East 27.37 feet to a
point of beginning.

PARCEL #2: That part of Lot 15 of Rancho Santa Ysabel
as surveyed and platted by R. R. Harris in October 1886,
and filed for record at page 29 of Book "A" in the San
Luis Obispo County Recorder's office, said part of Lot
15 being more particularly described as follows:
Commencing at SY 112 in the center line of Creston
Road, being former County Road No. 91 and running a-
long said center line North 50° 45' West 225.00 feet
to a point; thence leaving said line and running South
390' 15' West, thence leaving said line and running North
500' 30' West, 1196.50 feet to a point; thence running
to a point of beginning; thence running on a curve
500' 30' West, thence continuing North 30' West of be-
ginning; West, 20.80 feet to a point; thence running
to a point of curve; thence running on a curve
left tangent to last described course of 170' 07', havin-
distance of 300 feet, through an angle of 170' 07', havin-
former County Road No. 91 Right of Way 20'

WHEREAS, it further appears that said notices and publications thereof were in all respects as required by the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of California, entitled "Street Vacation Act of 1941" Division IX Part 3, Chapters 1 and 2 of the Streets and Highways Code, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been had on said proposed vacation as so noticed, and having heard all evidence offered by any persons interested, the City Council finds that the portion of Creston Road described in the Resolution of Intention is unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the public easement cease on the portion of Creston Road herein before described and vacated for public street purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk of this City cause a certified copy of this resolution to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of the County of San Luis Obispo, California.
