

VED, by the City Council of the City of Paso Robles,
and that it is the intention of this Council to undertake
certain public acquisitions and improvements within said City and
to assess the cost thereof on the lands benefited thereby, to-wit:

1. (a) The construction of 10-inch vitrified clay pipe sanitary sewer main with wye branches and standard manholes complete in State Highway between the pump station on the east side of the Salinas River to the east side of State Highway at its intersection with Creston Road, and an 8-inch vitrified clay pipe sanitary sewer main with wye branches and standard manholes complete between the west side of River Road and a point about 1500 feet easterly thereof.
 - (b) The construction of a sewage pumping station complete at the junction of River Road and State Highway No. 41.
 - (c) The construction of an 8-inch diameter cast iron sewerage pressure line in Salinas Street from 13th Street to 14th Street, and in 14th Street from Salinas Street to Riverside Avenue.
 - (d) The construction of a 6-inch vitrified clay pipe sanitary sewer main, wye branches and standard manholes complete in The Loop from its westerly intersection with Creston Road to its easterly intersection therewith.
 - (e) The doing of all work and the acquisition of lands and easements auxiliary to any of said work and to complete the same.
2. Reference is hereby made to the attached detailed drawings and specifications for a more particular description of the work to be done, and file in the office of the

3. The cost thereof will be assessed upon a district benefited thereby, the exterior boundaries of which are more particularly shown and delineated upon a plat thereof on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City.

4. That proceedings for said improvements shall be conducted pursuant to Division 4 of the Streets and Highways Code, the Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931, and the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913 (Deering Act 5215), and bonds shall be issued on the unpaid assessments thereof pursuant to the Refunding Assessment Bond Act of 1935 as modified in the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913.


