

RESOLUTION NO. 793

REQUESTING CONSENT OF THE COUNTY OF
SAN LUIS OBISPO TO ORDER THE CONSTRUC-
TION OF A SANITARY SEWERAGE SYSTEM
AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE COSTS THERE-
OF SHALL BE ASSESSED ON A SPECIAL
DISTRICT UNDER APPROPRIATE SPECIAL
ASSESSMENT AND ASSESSMENT BOND ACTS

CRESTON ROAD TRUNK SEWER

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Paso Robles,
California, that

WHEREAS, on May 19, 1952, this Council adopted Resolution
No. 774 Requesting the Consent of the County of San Luis Obispo to
Order the Construction of a Sanitary Sewerage System and to Provide
that the Costs Thereof Shall be Assessed on a Special District Un-
der Appropriate Special Assessment and Assessment Bond Acts;

WHEREAS, on May 27, 1952, the Board of Supervisors of
the County of San Luis Obispo adopted its resolution granting such
consent;

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications covering said pro-
ject have now been changed to include the following work:

The construction of a 6-inch vitrified clay pipe sani-
tary sewer main, wye branches and standard manholes complete in
The Loop from its westerly intersection with Creston Road to its
easterly intersection therewith;

WHEREAS, the Resolution of Intention has been amended to
include such additional work;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That request be, and the same is hereby, made that
the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo grant to
this Council its consent, by resolution, to the foregoing described
additional work.

2. That the City Clerk of this City be, and he is here-
by, directed to file with the County Clerk a certified copy of
this resolution.


