

RESOLUTION NO. 819

AWARDING SALE OF BONDS

OAK STREET
PROJECT NO. 52-2

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Paso Robles, California, that

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution of Intention No. 799 adopted by said Council on August 18, 1952, and its Resolution calling for bids on sale of bonds pursuant thereto, adopted December 15, 1952, notice of said sale has been duly given;

WHEREAS, this is the time and place fixed therein for receiving bids for the purchase of said bonds, and said bids have been received and publicly opened, examined and declared by this Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, as follows:

1. That all written bids received for the purchase of said bonds, excepting the bid herein stated, be, and they are hereby, rejected, and that said bonds, be, and they are hereby, ordered sold to J. B. HANAUER & CO. as the highest responsible bidder therefor, with interest to the date of delivery of said bonds, said sale to be subject to all of the terms and conditions set forth in said resolution calling for sealed proposals and in said accepted bid.

2. That the City Clerk be, and he is hereby, directed to have said bonds printed forthwith, and that the same be immediately signed and sealed and delivered to said bidder on receipt of the amount therefor as above stated, with interest but not otherwise, and upon the performance of the conditions contained in said written offer.

3. That the interest rate of said bonds be, and the same is hereby, fixed at the rate stated in said bid.


