

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION FOR THE
VACATION OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 123
IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES AND
GIVING NOTICE OF TIME AND PLACE OF
HEARING THEREON:

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That it is the intention of said City Council to close and vacate that alley in Block 123 in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State California; and is particularly described and bounded as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot 1, in Block 123 and run thence Southerly along the East line of said alley 300 feet to the North line of Third street; thence Westerly along said line 20 feet to the Southeast corner of Lot 7 in said Block 123; thence Northerly along the West line of said alley in Block 123, 300 feet to the South line of Fourth street; thence Easterly along said South line 20 feet to the point of beginning.


2. That Monday, March 2, 1953, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M. on said date, in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, Paso Robles, California, is the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed closing and vacation.

3. That the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles be and he is hereby directed to cause a copy of this Resolution of Intention to be published at least once a week for three weeks prior to the date set for hearing in the Paso Robles Press, a newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of El Paso de Robles.

4. That the Street Superintendent of the City of El Paso de Robles be and he is hereby instructed to cause a notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention and the time and place of hearing by conspicuously posting notices thereof along the line of the alley, or part thereof proposed to be closed and vacated, as required by law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in event of said closing, as hereinabove discribed, the City of El Paso de Robles will reserve a permanent easement for the installation, maintenance, repair or replacement of sewer lines, water lines and drainage facilities in said closed alley area and a right to ingress and egress for said purposes and further provided that no building shall be constructed or maintained in said closed area that would interfere with the exercise of said easement.
