

RESOLUTION NO. 828

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC INTEREST AND NECESSITY DEMAND THE ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION AND COMPLETION OF CERTAIN PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS

SEWAGE DISPOSAL PROJECT

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, California, that it be, and it is hereby, ordered and determined as follows;

1. The public interest and necessity demand the following municipal improvements, to-wit:

The acquisition and construction and completion of a sanitary sewage outfall, treatment works and disposal system, consisting of sewage treatment works, outfall sewer, interceptor sewers and trunk line mains, and the acquisition of any lands and easements necessary or useful therefor, and by doing such incidental work as may be necessary to complete such system.

2. The acquisitions and improvements mentioned in the foregoing section of this Resolution are necessary and convenient to carry out the objects, purposes and powers of the City.

3. The cost of said acquisitions and improvements will be too great to be paid out of the ordinary annual income and revenue of the City.

4. The said indebtedness will require an expenditure greater than the amount allowed for it by the annual tax levy of said City.
