

RESOLUTION NO. 830

CLOSING THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 123 IN
THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, California, having on the 2nd day of February, 1953, passed a Resolution of Intention to vacate that alley in Block 123 in the City of El Paso de Robles, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles did cause a copy of said Resolution of Intention to be published three successive weeks in the Paso Robles Press as required by law, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the Superintendent of Streets of the City of El Paso de Robles did cause to be conspicuously posted along the line of the alley as required by law, and

WHEREAS, it further appears that said notices and publications thereof were in all respects as required by the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of California, entitled "Street Vacation Act of 1941", Division IX, Part 3, Chapters 1 and 2 of the Streets and Highways Code, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been had on said proposed closing as so noticed, and having heard all evidence offered by any persons interested, the City Council finds that the alley so described in the Resolution of Intention is unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the public easement for street purposes in said alley cease with the City of El Paso de Robles reserving a permanent easement for the installation, maintenance, repair or replacement of sewer lines, water lines and drainage facilities in said closed alley area and a right to ingress and egress for said purposes and further provided that no building shall be constructed or maintained in said closed area that would interfere with the exercise of said easement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles cause a certified copy of this resolution to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of the County of San Luis Obispo, California.
