

RESOLUTION NO. 831

CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY THE PROPOSITION OF ISSUING REVENUE BONDS UNDER THE SANITATION, SEWER AND WATER REVENUE BOND LAW OF 1941 TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION, IMPROVING AND FINANCING OF A CERTAIN WATER SUPPLY, STORAGE, AND DISTRIBUTION ENTERPRISE, DECLARING THE ESTIMATED COST OF THE ENTERPRISE, THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF THE BONDS AND THE MAXIMUM RATE OF INTEREST TO BE PAID THEREON; PROVIDING FOR THE CONSOLIDATION OF THE ELECTION WITH A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION, AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE THEREOF.

WATER PROJECT

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, San Luis Obispo County, California, as follows:

1. A special municipal election is hereby called and ordered and will be held in the City of El Paso de Robles on Tuesday the 14th day of April, 1953, at which election shall be submitted to the qualified voters the proposition of issuing revenue bonds pursuant to the Sanitation, Sewer and Water Revenue Bond Law of 1941 of the State of California, for the purpose of providing funds for the objects and purposes set forth in the following proposition, to-wit:

PROPOSITION: Shall the City of El Paso de Robles issue revenue bonds in the principal amount of \$150,000.00, for the acquisition, construction, improving and financing of an enterprise, including expenses incidental thereto, said enterprise to consist of the acquisition and drilling of wells; acquisition of pumps and replacements; extension of water mains; and making additions, extensions and improvements to the city water works and system, including all parts of the enterprise, all appurtenances thereto, and land, easements, water supply, storage and distribution facilities and equipment, pursuant to the Sanitation, Sewer and Water Revenue Bond Law of 1941?

2. The estimated cost of the acquisition, construction, improving and financing of the enterprise, and the expenses incidental thereto, as set forth in the proposition, is the sum of \$150,000.00.

3. The principal amount of the bonds to be issued therefor is \$150,000.00 and the rate of interest to be paid on the bonds shall not exceed six per cent (6%) per annum.

4. The Council does hereby submit to the qualified voters of the City, at the special municipal election, this resolution and the proposition set forth in Section 1 hereof. The Council proposes

to issue and sell revenue bonds of the City in the Amount and for the objects and purposes specified in the proposition if a majority of all the voters voting on the proposition vote in favor thereof.

5. The bonds, including the interest thereon, shall be a special obligation of the City, payable exclusively from and secured by the revenue of the enterprise, and shall not be secured by the taxing power of the City, and the City and its officers shall not be under any obligation to pay same excepting from said revenues.

6. All of the bonds of this series are equally and ratably secured without priority by reason of number, sale, execution or delivery, by a lien upon the revenues herein pledged to the payment thereof.

7. The said special municipal election shall be held and conducted, the votes thereof canvassed, the returns thereof made, and result thereof ascertained and determined as herein provided; and all other particulars not prescribed by this resolution the election shall be held and the votes canvassed pursuant to law for general municipal elections in the City.

8. The said special municipal election is hereby consolidated with the special municipal election which will be held within the City, on Tuesday, the 14th day of April, 1953. The special municipal election hereby called shall be held in the manner provided for the special municipal election with which it is consolidated, and the precincts, polling places, and officers of election shall be the same as those set forth in Ordinance No.176, N.S. An Ordinance Calling a Special Election in the City of El Paso de Robles for the Purpose of Submitting to the Electors of said City a Proposition of Incurring Bonded Indebtedness of said City for the Acquisition and Construction and Completion of Certain Municipal Improvements; Declaring the Estimated Costs of said Municipal Improvements, the Amounts of the Principal of said Indebtedness to be Incurred therefor, and the Maximum Rate of Interest to be Paid Thereon; Fixing the Date of said Election, the Manner of Holding

the same and providing for Notice Thereof, adopted by the City Council on March 2, 1953.

9. The elections hereby consolidated shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election and only one form of ballot shall be used.

10. All persons qualified to vote at the special municipal election called by said Ordinance No.176, N.S. shall be qualified to vote upon the proposition submitted at the special municipal election hereby called.

11. Ballots for the election shall be provided of the form and to the number provided by law. On ballots, in addition to any other printed matter which may be required by law, two voting squares shall be set off to the right of the proposition submitted at the election and set forth in Section 1 of this resolution, one having the word "YES" printed before it and the other having the word "NO" printed before it.

12. Each voter to vote for the proposition and for the issuance of the bonds shall stamp a cross (X) in the blank space opposite the word "YES" on the ballot to the right of the proposition, and to vote against the proposition and against the issuance of the bonds, shall stamp a cross (X) in the blank space opposite the word "NO" on the ballot to the right of the proposition.

13. The polls shall be opened at 7:00 o'clock A.M. of the day of the election and shall be kept open until 7:00 o'clock P.M. of the same day, when the polls shall be closed, except as to voters in line as provided in Section 5734 of the Elections Code.

14. This ordinance shall be published once a week for two successive weeks in the Paso Robles Press, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published less than six days a week in said City, and such publication shall constitute notice of said election. No other notice of the election hereby called need be given.
