

RESOLUTION NO. 832

MAKING APPLICATION TO THE  
STATE BOARD OF PUBLIC HEALTH.

RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that pursuant and subject to all of the terms, conditions and provisions of Division 5, Part 1, Chapter 7, Sections 4010 to 4035 of the California Health and Safety Code and all amendments thereto, relating to domestic water supplies, application by this City be made to the State Board of Public Health, for a permit to use the existing water supply system and connect to and use proposed new water wells.


The existing system now consists of eleven wells adjacent to the Salinas River, supply mains, pumping and chlorination plants and an elevated reservoir.

Due to expansion the City proposes to connect three new wells (Sherwood Field Well, Creston Park Well and Borthardt Well) to the existing system.

The area to be served consists of the City of El Paso de Robles and adjacent fringe areas in County territory.

That the Mayor of said City Council be and is hereby authorized and directed to cause the necessary data to be prepared, and investigations to be made, and in the name of said City to sign and file such application with the said State Board of Public Health.
