RESOLUTION NO. 833

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES REGARDING
RETIRING MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, by its action and by enabling legislation of the State of California, has made social security benefits available to all municipal employees of this City; and

WHEREAS, the action of the City Council in this regard was the result of unanimous ballot of all City employees; and

WHEREAS, on January 1, 1953, more liberal benefits became effective under the Federal Social Security Regulations and are available to the municipal employees of this City; and

WHEREAS, firemen and police officers are frequently subjected to extreme physical exertion in carrying out their duties; and

WHEREAS, the City Council feels it is for the best interests of the City of El Paso de Robles and its firemen and police officers that such firemen and police officers be retired when they reach their Sixty-fifth birthday;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that all present firemen and police officers of said City and all future firemen and police officers be retired when they have reached or when in the future they shall reach their Sixty-fifth birthday.

RESOLVED FURTHER that this Resolution shall go into effect and be declared the policy of this City on the 30th day of ______, 1953.
