RESOLUTION NO. <u>838</u> CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULT OF BOND ELECTION HELD APRIL 14, 1953 SEWAGE DISPOSAL

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, San Luis Obispo County, California, that

WHEREAS, said Council by Ordinance No. 176, N.S. adopted on the 2nd day of March, 1953, duly called and ordered held in the bond said City a special municipal/election on the 14th day of April, 1953, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors thereof the propositions therein set forth;

WHEREAS, said special municipal bond election was held and conducted on said day, as required by law and said ordinance;

WHEREAS, it appears that notice of said election was duly and legally given, that voting precincts were properly established therefor, that polling place cards and sample ballots were mailed to all registered voters in the City, election officers were appointed and election supplies furnished; and that in all respects said election was held and conducted and the votes cast thereat received and canvassed, and the returns thereof made, determined and declared in time, form and manner as required by the laws providing for and regulating municipal bond elections in said City;

WHEREAS, the Council of said City met at the Council Chambers thereof on <u>Monday</u>, April <u>20th</u>, 1953, to canwass the returns of said election and declare the result thereof;

WHEREAS, said canvass was duly completed and the results thereof are as hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY FOUND, DETERMINED AND RESOLVED, as follows:

1. That said special municipal bond election was held and conducted in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, on Tuesday, April 14, 1953, in the time, form and manner required by law. 2. That there were two voting precincts established in said City for the purpose of holding said election, which consisted of consolidations of El Paso de Robles County Election Precincts as last established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo for the conduct of State and County elections and which were designated Consolidated Election Precincts Nos. "A" and "B".

3. That a canvass of the votes cast in said City upon the measures thereat submitted was duly held in accordance with the order of the Council and in accordance with law.

4. That the whole number of votes cast at the said precincts in said City of El Paso de Robles at said special municipal bond election was ______.

5. That the propositions voted upon in said special municipal bond election, the number of votes received for and against said proposition in the precincts established therefor are as follows:

PROPOSITION:Shall the City of El Paso de RoblesSEWAGE DISPOSALincur a bonded indebtedness in the
principal amount of \$200,000.00 inaccordance with the provisions of the ordinance of saidCity calling the election at which this proposition is
submitted, for the objects and purposes of acquiring and
constructing and completing the following municipal im-
provements, to wit: A sanitary sewage outfall, treatment
works and disposal system, consisting of sewage treatment
works, outfall sewer, interceptor sewers and trunk line
mains, and the acquisition of any lands and easements
necessary or useful therefor, and by ding such incidental
work as may be necessary to complete such system?

6. That <u>10</u> duly registered voters, who expected to be absent from their respective election precincts on the day of the election secured ballots from the City Clerk.

7. That the city clerk has certified to this Council that 9______ of said absentee ballots issued or mailed by him have been returned within the time required by law. 8. That the City Council canvassed said absentee ballots and counted the same personally, whereupon it was found that the result of the ballots cast by said absentee voters, without regard which to the precincts within/the voters are registered, were ______ votes for and ______ votes against said proposition.

9. That the total votes cast in said City for and against the proposition is as follows:

10. That more than two-thirds of all the votes cast for and against said proposition at the special municipal bond election were in favor of the proposition and authorized the incurring of the bonded debt for the purpose set forth in the proposition and the proposition carried.

11. That the City Clerk be, and he is hereby, instructed to enter this **testolution**, in full, on the minutes of this Council as a statement of the result of said special municipal bond election.
