

RESOLUTION NO. 839

CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULT
OF REVENUE BOND ELECTION HELD APRIL
14, 1953

WATER PROJECT

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, San Luis Obispo County, California, that

WHEREAS, said Council by Resolution No. 831 adopted on the 2nd day of March, 1953, duly called and ordered held in said City a special municipal revenue bond election on the 14th day of April, 1953, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors thereof the proposition therein set forth;

WHEREAS, said election was held and conducted on said day, as required by law and said resolution;

WHEREAS, it appears that notice of said election was duly and legally given, that voting precincts were properly established therefor, that polling place cards and sample ballots were mailed to all registered voters in the City, election officers were appointed and election supplies furnished; and that in all respects said election was held and conducted and the votes cast thereat received and canvassed, and the returns thereof made, determined and declared in time, form and manner as required by the laws providing for and regulating municipal revenue bond elections in said City;

WHEREAS, the Council of said City met at the Council Chambers thereof on Monday, April 20th, 1953, to canvass the returns of said election and declare the result thereof;

WHEREAS, said canvass was duly completed and the results thereof are as hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY FOUND, DETERMINED AND RESOLVED, as follows:

1. That said special municipal revenue bond election was held and conducted in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of

San Luis Obispo, State of California, on Tuesday, April 14, 1953, in the time, form and manner as required by law.

2. That said election was consolidated with the special municipal election held within the City on the same day, and the voting precincts were the same for both elections.

3. That a canvass of the votes cast in said City upon the measure thereat submitted was duly held in accordance with the order of the Council and in accordance with law.

4. That the whole number of votes cast at the said precincts in said City of El Paso de Robles at said special municipal revenue bond election was 789.

5. That the proposition voted upon in said municipal revenue bond election and the number of votes received for and against the proposition in the precincts established therefor, are as follows:

PROPOSITION:

(Water Project) Shall the City of El Paso de Robles issue revenue bonds in the principal amount of \$150,000.00, for the acquisition, construction, improving and financing of an enterprise, including expenses incidental thereto, said enterprise to consist of the acquisition and drilling of wells; acquisition of pumps and replacements; extension of water mains; and making additions, extensions and improvements to the city water works and system, including all parts of the enterprise, all appurtenances thereto, and land, easements, water supply, storage and distribution facilities and equipment, pursuant to the Sanitation, Sewer and Water Revenue Bond Law of 1941?

6. That 10 duly registered voters, who expected to be absent from their respective election precincts on the day of election secured ballots from the City Clerk.

7. That the City Clerk has certified to this Council that 9 of said absentee ballots issued or mailed by him have been returned within the time required by law.

8. That the City Council canvassed said absentee ballots and counted the same personally, whereupon it was found that the result of the ballots cast by said absentee voters, without regard to the precincts within which the voters are registered, were 9 votes for and 0 votes against said proposition.

9. That the total number of votes cast in said City for and against the Proposition is as follows:

10. That a majority of all of the votes cast for and against the proposition at said special municipal ~~revenue~~ bond election were in favor of the proposition and authorized the issuance of the revenue bonds for the purpose set forth in the proposition and that said proposition carried.

11. That the City Clerk be, and he is hereby, instructed to enter this resolution, in full, on the minutes of this Council as a statement of the result of said special municipal revenue bond election.




