

RESOLUTION NO. 855

A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ESTABLISH  
CERTAIN STREET GRADES IN THE CITY OF  
EL PASO DE ROBLES

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE  
ROBLES DOES HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

That it is the intention of the City Council  
of the City of El Paso de Robles to order the following  
street work to be done, to wit:

To change and establish the official grades on  
the streets and portions of streets of said City of El  
Paso de Robles hereinafter particularly designated and  
in the manner hereinafter specified.

All the herein proposed work shall be done in  
pursuance of an act of the Legislature of the State of  
California, cited as Change of Grade Act of 1909.

The Paso Robles Press is hereby designated as  
the daily newspaper published and circulated in said City  
in which this Resolution of Intention and the Street  
Superintendent's notices of passage thereof shall be  
published.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish  
this resolution by two successive insertions in said  
newspaper and to post the same for two days consecutively  
on or near the chamber door of said City Council.

The streets and portions of streets on which it  
is intended to change the grade and the official grades it  
is proposed to establish are as shown and delineated on  
the following plans, profiles and cross-sections which are  
on file in the office of the City Clerk in said City:



"Plan and Profile No. 118, Vine Street Improvement from 22nd Street to 24th Street, Major Street Project No. 31 City of El Paso de Robles.

"Cross-Sections, Vine Street Improvement, from 22nd Street to 24th Street, Project No. 31 City of El Paso de Robles." (In two sheets.)

The elevations of the grades to be established are shown and delineated on the above plans, profiles and cross-sections in feet and decimals of a foot. The figures following the designation of grade points indicate the number of feet that such points are above sea level, and are fixed and established with reference to a common datum plane and standard bench mark consisting of the top of a brass bolt set in the nosing of the cast iron sill of the building at the Northeast corner of Twelfth and Spring Streets in said City, the said datum plane and standard bench mark being at the elevation of 738.60 feet above sea level.
