

RESOLUTION NO. 881

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION
AND CONSOLIDATING REGULAR ELECTION PRECINCTS, APPOINT-
ING ELECTION OFFICERS AND PROVIDING PAYMENT THEREFOR.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES,
CALIFORNIA, MEETING IN REGULAR SESSION ON THIS 15TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1954, THAT A
REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION BE HELD IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES ON TUESDAY,
APRIL 13, 1954, AT WHICH ELECTION THE FOLLOWING OFFICERS SHALL BE ELECTED, TO-WIT:

ONE CITY COUNCILMAN FOR A FOUR YEAR TERM
ONE CITY COUNCILMAN FOR A FOUR YEAR TERM

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE FOLLOWING VOTING PRECINCTS BE AND THE
SAME ARE HEREBY ESTABLISHED FOR SAID ELECTION, TO-WIT:

PRECINCT "A" SHALL COMPRISE OF THE REGULAR ELECTION PRECINCTS ESTABLISHED
FOR THE HOLDING OF STATE AND COUNTY ELECTIONS; PASO ROBLES No. 1; PASO
ROBLES No. 2; PASO ROBLES No. 3; PASO ROBLES No. 4; PASO ROBLES No. 5;
PASO ROBLES No. 12 AND PASO ROBLES No. 13. THE POLLING PLACE FOR PRECINCT
"A" SHALL BE AT THE CIVIC AUDITORIUM, 820 - 10TH STREET, PASO ROBLES, CAL-
IFORNIA.

PRECINCT "B" SHALL COMPRISE OF THE REGULAR ELECTION PRECINCTS ESTABLISHED
FOR THE HOLDING OF STATE AND COUNTY ELECTIONS: PASO ROBLES No. 6; PASO
ROBLES No. 7; PASO ROBLES No. 8; PASO ROBLES No. 9; PASO ROBLES No. 10;
AND PASO ROBLES No. 11. THE POLLING PLACE FOR PRECINCT "B" SHALL BE AT
THE BOY SCOUT BUILDING, 2249 OAK STREET, PASO ROBLES, CALIFORNIA.

THE POLLING PLACES HEREIN DESIGNATED SHALL REMAIN OPEN ON THE DAY OF
ELECTION BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7 O'CLOCK A.M. AND 7 O'CLOCK P.M.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE FOLLOWING NAMED PERSONS ARE HEREBY
