RESOLUTION NO. 892 REGARDING MAIL SERVICE

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, California, that

WHEREAS, the City of Paso Robles, California, has been severely handicapped by lack of adequate mail service; and

WHEREAS, all southbound mail from this city, which is deposited after noon of any business day, is taken by bus to Salinas, 100 miles north, and then trans-shipped by rail to Los Angeles and intermediate points; and

WHEREAS, this city is served by Pacific Greyhound Lines Schedule 16, which departs from Paso Robles for Los Angeles at 6:24 P. M., daily;

BE, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:

That the United States Post Office Department request that adequate space be reserved on said Pacific Greyhound Lines Schedule 16 to transport local southbound mail by said bus to Los Angeles and intermediate points; and

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Postmaster, Paso Robles, California, and that a certified copy be forwarded to the Traffic Manager, Pacific Greyhound Lines for his information.
