

RESOLUTION NO. 1162

A RESOLUTION OVERRULING PROTESTS ON RESOLUTION OF
INTENTION NO. 1148

GOLF COURSE TRACT NO. 147

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of El Paso de
Robles, California, that

WHEREAS, this Council did on December 7, 1959, adopt its
Resolution of Intention No. 1148 to acquire and construct public
improvements in and for said City;

WHEREAS, on December 7, 1959, this Council adopted a
resolution appointing time and place of hearing protests in
relation to the proposed acquisitions and improvements and
directing notice;

WHEREAS, notice was given of the time and place therein
stated in the manner provided by law, as appears from the affi-
davits on file in the office of the City Clerk;

WHEREAS, said matter came on regularly for hearing at the
time therein fixed; and

WHEREAS, all written protests and other written communi-
cations were publicly read at said meeting and all persons desir-
ing to be heard were fully heard;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, as follows:


1. That protests against said acquisitions and improvements
were not signed by the owners of a majority or more of the area of
the lands within the assessment district, or of the area of the
lands within the assessment district assessed for the costs and
expenses of said work.
