

RESOLUTION NO. 1178

CONSOLIDATING REGULAR ELECTION PRECINCTS  
AND THE APPOINTMENT OF ELECTION OFFICERS


BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that for the purpose of holding a regular municipal election in the City of El Paso de Robles on Tuesday, April 12, 1960, there will be two voting precincts consisting of the regular election precincts in the City of El Paso de Robles established for the holding of state and county elections; that the polling places for the respective precincts shall be the places hereinafter designated; and that the persons hereinafter named be appointed officers of election for their respective voting precincts:

PRECINCT "A" Comprised of regular election precincts numbered Paso Robles No.1, Paso Robles No.2, Paso Robles No.3, Paso Robles No.5, Paso Robles No.8, Paso Robles, No.12 and Paso Robles No.13. The polling place shall be at the Civic Auditorium, 820 - 10th Street, Paso Robles, California. The following named persons are appointed as election officers: Inspector - Leo Oberg, Judge - Mrs. Luella Taylor, Clerk - Mrs. LaViolette L. Moss and Clerk - Mrs. Doris A. Smith.

PRECINCT "B" Comprised of regular election precincts numbered Paso Robles No.4, Paso Robles No.6, Paso Robles No.7, Paso Robles No.9, Paso Robles No.10 and Paso Robles No.11. The polling place shall be at the Glen Speck School Office, 18th and Vine Streets, Paso Robles California. The following named persons are appointed as election officers: Inspector - Harry R. Edwards, Judge - Mrs. Anita Nuefeld, Clerk - Mrs. Florence N. Ede and Clerk - Mrs. Ella L. Walton.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the polling places herein named shall remain open between the hours of 7:00 o'clock A.M. and 7:00 o'clock P.M. on the day of election.
