

RESOLUTION NO. 1185

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES TO INITIATE ON  
ITS OWN MOTION PROCEEDINGS TO ANNEX CERTAIN  
UNINHABITED TERRITORY

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO  
DE ROBLES:

1. That the Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, for the reasons hereinafter mentioned, proposes to initiate on its own motion, as soon as it can legally do so, proceedings to annex to the City of El Paso de Robles, all of the territory hereinafter described, as uninhabited territory, under provisions of the Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1938 as set forth in Sections 35300 to 35325, inclusive, of the Government Code of the State of California.

2. That the Council's reasons for proposing to initiate said annexation proceedings are as follows: The annexation of the hereinafter described territory will contribute to the orderly growth of the city, provide the proper control of street layout, drainage, sanitary sewer design, and insure the proper use of land in conformity with the overall zoning plan of the city.


3. That the territory which the Council proposes to annex is hereby identified as "Annexation No. 10 - portion of Olive Park" and consists of all that real property situate in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, described as follows:

Beginning at a point lying in the south line of County Road No. 124, (60 feet wide) said point also lying in the produced westerly line of Lot 21, Olive Park Tract, Book A, page 32 of Maps records of the County of San Luis Obispo, California; thence NORTH along said produced line and the westerly line of Lots 21 and 22 1,591.86 feet to the southeasterly corner of Lot 24 of said Tract; thence N67° 45' W along the southerly line of

Lots 24 and 25 of said Tract 712.70 feet to a point; thence N89° 32' W 571.16 feet to a point; thence N65° 47' W 328.65 feet to a point lying in the City Boundary of the City of El Paso de Robles; thence Northerly, Easterly, Southerly and Westerly along said City Boundary to the point of beginning.

4. That the City Engineer of the City of El Paso de Robles is hereby directed to file with the Boundary Commission of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, this proposal to initiate proceedings to annex the hereinabove described uninhabited territory to the City of El Paso de Robles, and to request a report by the Commission as provided for in Section 35002 of the Government Code.
