

RESOLUTION NO. 1191

RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT PROCEEDINGS HAVE BEEN INITIATED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES TO ANNEX TO SAID CITY CERTAIN UNINHABITED TERRITORY DESCRIBED HEREIN AND DESIGNATED "ANNEXATION NO. 10", AND GIVING NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES:

1. That, pursuant to the provisions of the Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939, proceedings have been initiated by the Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, on its own motion, to annex to the City of El Paso de Robles all that uninhabited territory situate in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, hereby designated as "Annexation No. 10" and described as follows:

Beginning at a point lying in the south line of County Road No. 124, (60 feet wide) said point also lying in the produced westerly line of Lot 21, Olive Park Tract, Book A, page 32 of Maps records of the County of San Luis Obispo, California; thence NORTH along said produced line and the westerly line of Lots 21 and 22 1,591.86 feet to the southeasterly corner of Lot 24 of said Tract; thence N67° 45' W along the southerly line of Lots 24 and 25 of said Tract 712.70 feet to a point; thence N89° 32' W 571.16 feet to a point; thence N65° 47' W 328.65 feet to a point lying in the City Boundary of the City of El Paso de Robles; thence Northerly, Easterly, Southerly and Westerly along said City Boundary to the point of beginning.

2. That the Council of the City of El Paso de Robles desires to annex said uninhabited territory to the City of El Paso de Robles for the following reasons:
The territory is contiguous to the City of El Paso de Robles, and its proposed annexation will contribute to and facilitate the orderly growth and development of both the City and the territory proposed to be annexed; will facilitate and contribute to the proper and orderly layout, design and construction of streets, gutters, sidewalks, sanitary and storm water sewers

and drainage facilities, both within the City and within the territory proposed to be annexed; and will provide and facilitate proper overall planning and zoning of lands, and subdivisions of lands in said City and said uninhabited territory, in a manner most conducive to the welfare of said City and said uninhabited territory.

3. That the County Boundary Commission of San Luis Obispo County, California, did in session duly assembled on Thursday, March 24, 1960, approve the proposed annexation boundaries of said "Annexation No.10" as above described, and as submitted to said Commission by the Council of the City of El Paso de Robles.

4. That Monday, June 6, 1960, at the hour of 8:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers in the City Hall in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, California, is hereby fixed as the time and place when and where any person owning real property within the uninhabited territory above described and proposed to be annexed to the City of El Paso de Robles, and having any objections to the proposed annexation, may appear before the Council of the City of El Paso de Robles and show cause why such uninhabited territory should not be so annexed to said City of El Paso de Robles. Such protests must be in writing, may be filed at any time before the hour set for hearing objections to the proposed annexation, and shall state the name or names of the owner or owners of property affected, and the description and area of such property, in general terms.

5. The City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles is hereby authorized and directed to cause a copy of this resolution to be published at least twice but not oftener than once a week, in the Paso Robles Press, a newspaper of general circulation published in said City of El Paso de Robles, the city to which it is proposed to annex the aforesaid territory, and also in the Telegram-Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation published outside the City of El Paso de Robles, but in the County of San Luis Obispo, California, the County in which is located

the territory proposed to be annexed to the City of El Paso de Robles, said publication to be complete at least twenty (20) days prior to the date set for hearing.

6. The City Clerk is furthur authorized and directed to cause written notice of such proposed annexation to be mailed to each person to whom land within the territory proposed to be annexed is assessed in the last equalized county assessment roll available on the date the above said proceedings were initiated, at the addresses shown on said assessment roll or known to the Clerk, and to any person who has filed his name and address and the designation of the lands in which he has an interest, either legal or equitable, with the Clerk, such notice to be given not less than twenty (20) days before the first public hearing on the proposed annexation.

7. In the event any land within the territory proposed to be annexed is owned by a county, the City Clerk is directed to cause written notice of such proposed annexation to be mailed to the Board of Supervisors of the County, such notice to be given not less than twenty (20) days before the first public hearing on the proposed annexation.

8. In the event there is, upon the land proposed to be annexed, a structural improvement owned, being acquired or leased by a county fire protection district, the said Clerk is directed to cause written notice of such proposed annexation to be mailed to the governing body of such district, such notice to be sent not less than ten (10) days before the first public hearing upon such proposed annexation.

9. The City Clerk is directed to cuase written notice to be given to such other persons as may be legally entitled thereto, in the manner required by law.



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
