

RESOLUTION NO. 1197

A RESOLUTION SETTING THE CITY TAX RATE AND APPORTIONMENTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1960-61

RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, California, as follows:

1. That the tax rate on the taxable property within the City of El Paso de Robles for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1960, be fixed at \$1.97 on each One Hundred Dollars of assessed valuation as established for tax purposes by the Assessor of the City of El Paso de Robles.

2. That all taxes collected on each One Hundred Dollars of the assessed valuation at the rate of \$1.97 be apportioned to the City Funds as follows:

SEWER MAINTENANCE FUND . . . . .	\$ .15
PARK AND RECREATION FUND . . . . .	\$ .33

1953 SEWER BOND FUND . . . . .	\$ .11
1960 SEWER BOND FUND . . . . .	\$ .17
