RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES IN MEMORY OF
SENATOR A. A. ERHART

WHEREAS, for over seventeen years the late Senator A. A. Erhart served as a member of the Board of Supervisors of San Luis Obispo County; and

WHEREAS, since May, 1951, the Honorable A. A. Erhart vigorously and effectively represented our County of San Luis Obispo as a member of the State Senate of the State of California, serving on many of the State committees and sub-committees, and being elected Chairman of the important Senate Agricultural Committee; and

WHEREAS, during these many years past Senator Erhart was completely approachable and helpful to all residents of our County, devoting his best efforts to the problems of our County, the problems of the cities in San Luis Obispo County and to the problems of each of our County residents; and

WHEREAS, last week Senator Erhart was suddenly taken from us at the point of the highest accomplishment of his long period of public life;

BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of EL PASO DE ROBLES:

1. All the residents of the City of El Paso de Robles, of the County of San Luis Obispo, and the citizens of the State of California have lost an able, forthright, conscientious and devoted legislator when Senator Erhart was suddenly taken by death on Friday, August 12, 1960;

2. Each member of the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does extend his condolences to the widow of Senator Erhart and to his family.


3. That the City Clerk be instructed to send certified copies of this Resolution to Mrs. Erhart and to the Secretary of the California State Senate.
