

RESOLUTION NO. 1218

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC
INTEREST AND NECESSITY DEMAND THE
ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION AND COMPLETION
OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, California, that it be and it is hereby ordered and determined, as follows:

1. That the public interest and necessity demand the acquisition, construction and completion of the improvements set forth in the following proposition, to wit:

"Shall the City of El Paso de Robles incur a bonded indebtedness in the amount of \$75,000 for the acquisition, construction and completion, including any or all expenses incidental thereto, or connected therewith, of a municipal swimming pool together with bath houses, structures and facilities appurtenant thereto and the acquisition of all lands and easements necessary or useful therefor and by doing such incidental work as may be necessary to complete said improvements?"

2. That the improvements mentioned in said proposition are necessary and convenient to carry out the objects, purposes and powers of the City.

3. That the cost of said improvements will be too great to be paid out of the ordinary accumulation of income and revenue of the City.
