

RESOLUTION NO. 1222

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO VACATE AND CLOSE A PUBLIC STREET IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES AND GIVING NOTICE OF HEARING AND TIME AND PLACE SET THEREON.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That it is the intention of said City Council to close and vacate that portion of Ninth Street in the City of El Paso de Robles as shown on a map and plan on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles and hereby referred to for further particulars, said area being more particularly described as follows:

That portion of Ninth Street, 80 feet in width, that extends from the east line of Pine Street to the westerly line of the Southern Pacific Railroad Right of Way as shown on the map of Subdivision of Block 231 in the City of El Paso de Robles as filed for record in the Recorder's office of San Luis Obispo County on February 17, 1893.

2. That Monday, April 3, 1961, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. in the City Council Chamber of the City Hall, Paso Robles, California, is the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or having objections to the proposed closing and vacation.

3. That the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles be and he is hereby directed to cause a copy of this Resolution of Intention to be published in the manner prescribed by law.

4. That the Director of Public Works of the City of El Paso de Robles be and he is hereby directed to cause notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention and of the time and place set for hearing by conspicuously posting notices thereof along the line of the street proposed to be closed and vacated.

5. That in the event of said closing, as hereinabove described, the City of El Paso de Robles will reserve and except from the vacation the permanent easement and right at any time, or from time to time, to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove and renew sanitary sewers, storm drains and water lines and appurtenant structures in, upon, over and across any of the vacated street area and pursuant to any existing franchise or renewals thereof, or otherwise, to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles and

other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures for the operation of gas pipe lines, telegraphic and telephone lines and for the transportation and distribution of electric energy and incidental purposes, including access to protect the property from all hazards in, upon and over said closed street area.
