

RESOLUTION NO. 1225

A RESOLUTION CLOSING AN ALLEY  
IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, having on the 20th day of March, 1961, passed a Resolution of Intention to vacate and close an alley in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, which is more particularly described as follows:

That alley, 12 feet in width, that lies between Blocks 10 and 11 as shown on the map of T. H. McFarlain's Subdivision of Villa Lots 3, 4, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 in Riverside Farm No.6, Paso Robles, as filed for record in the Recorder's office of San Luis Obispo County on June 30, 1888.

WHEREAS, it appears that the City Clerk did cause said Resolution of Intention to be published in the Paso Robles Press as required by law; and

WHEREAS, it also appears that the Director of Public Works did cause notices to be posted along the said alley as required by law; and

WHEREAS, it further appears that said notices and publications were in all respects as required by the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of California entitled, "Street Vacation Act of 1941", Division IX, Part 3, Chapters 1 and 2 of the Streets and Highways Code; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on said proposed closing as so noticed, and having heard all evidence offered by any person interested, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles finds that the alley as described is unnecessary for present or prospective future street purposes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the public easement cease on said alley hereinbefore described and be vacated for public street purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California.
