RESOLUTION OPPOSING TRANSFER OF LIQUOR LICENSE REVENUE

WHEREAS it has recently come to the attention of this City that certain members of the California Legislature are seeking to have a substantial portion of the Cities' share of liquor license revenue taken from the Cities' and allocate same to the Counties; and

WHEREAS this City and other general law Cities are faced with ever increasing demands upon the Cities' sources of revenue; and

WHEREAS such a proposed reallocation is not just and is not for the best interests of the citizens of the State of California;


BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles as follows:

(1) That the City Council of this City vigorously opposes the transfer of the Cities' share of liquor license revenue from the incorporated Cities of the State of California to the Counties;

(2) That a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to Governor Brown for his information;

RESOLVED FURTHER that certified copies of this Resolution be forwarded to Honorable Vernon L. Sturgeon and James Holmes, Senator and Assemblyman respectively for this area.
