RESOLUTION REGARDING TELEPHONE IN LIEU TAX

WHEREAS the California State Legislature at the 1961 session considered a proposed One Percent (1%) tax on intra-state telephone company receipts to replace Franchise fees previously paid for the privilege of doing intra-state business; and

WHEREAS the Senate has previously passed and approved such a proposal; and

WHEREAS there exists an emergency to recapture the amount of Franchise fees previously paid to various Cities in the State of California;


BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles as follows:

(1) That the City Council of this City respectively requests the Governor of California to include in his call for the Special Session the item permitting the State Legislature to consider a proposed Constitutional Amendment to be voted upon in the fall election of 1962;

(2) The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Governor of the State of California, for his information.

RESOLVED FURTHER that the City Clerk is directed to forward certified copies of this Resolution to the Senator and Assemblyman from this area.
