

RESOLUTION NO. 1269

A RESOLUTION URGING THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO RECONSIDER ITS PREVIOUSLY STATED INTENTION OF APPLYING THE COUNTY'S SHARE OF MOTOR VEHICLE IN LIEU TAXES FOR ROAD PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the County Board of Supervisors has tentatively announced its decision to reduce road district taxes in the unincorporated areas and to apply motor vehicle in lieu taxes to meet road construction expenses, thus reducing road district taxes from 12¢ to approximately 3¢; and

WHEREAS, the motor vehicle in lieu tax was historically a personal property tax used for general county purposes, thus reducing the amount of other taxes to be raised; and

WHEREAS, the burden of local property taxes for city, school and county purposes is becoming greater all the time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that the County Board of Supervisors be asked to continue the practice of supporting the county road construction and maintenance budget with road district taxes and tailoring the expenditure program to the available road district and gas tax funds without drawing on the in lieu taxes and thus increasing the general county tax rate.


