

RESOLUTION NO. 1280

A RESOLUTION CLOSING A STREET IN
THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, having on the 17th day of September, 1962, passed a Resolution of Intention to vacate and close a portion of Fifth Street in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, which is more particularly described as follows:

That portion of Fifth Street, 80 feet in width, that extends from the east line of Olive Street to a point and line that is 120 feet easterly from the east line of Olive Street as shown on the Map of City of El Paso de Robles as filed for record in Recorder's office of San Luis Obispo County on October 25, 1889.

WHEREAS, it appears that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles did cause said Resolution of Intention to be published in the Paso Robles Press as required by law; and

WHEREAS, it also appears that the Director of Public Works for the City of El Paso de Robles did cause notices to be posted along said street as required by law; and

WHEREAS, it further appears that said publications and notices were in all respects as required by the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of California entitled, "Street Vacation Act of 1941", Division IX, Part 3, Chapters 1 and 2 of the Streets and Highways Code; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on said proposed closing as heard so noticed, and having/all evidence offered by any person interested, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles finds that the portion of Fifth Street so described is unnecessary for present or prospective future public street purposes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the public easement cease on said street hereinbefore described and be vacated for public street purposes.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said closing does reserve therefrom an easement subject to the rights of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a California Corporation, its successors and assigns, to erect, maintain, replace, remove and use a line of poles with all necessary and proper cross-arms, braces, anchors, guys and other appliances and fixtures for use in connection therewith, and to suspend therefrom, maintain and use such wires as

Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall from time to time deem necessary for the transmission and distribution of electric energy, together with a right of way along said line of poles, over and across the southerly fifteen feet of the lands herein abandoned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California.
