

RESOLUTION NO. 1152

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL GRANT FOR SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS UNDER 33 U.S.C. 466 ET SEQ.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, California:

Section 1. That the public interest, health, welfare and convenience require and that it is the intention of the City of El Paso de Robles, California to improve the sewerage system by construction of a new intercepting sewer and a treatment plant addition.

Section 2. That it is the intention of the City of El Paso de Robles, California, to make application for Federal Grant to the U.S. Department of Interior, Federal Pollution Control Administration, for assistance in the construction of these projects.

Section 3. That it is the intention of the City of El Paso de Robles, California, to pay for the remaining cost of the project, if a Federal Grant for the project is made pursuant to the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 466 et seq.).

Section 4. That it is the intention of the City of El Paso de Robles, California, to provide proper and efficient operation and maintenance of the project after it is constructed.

Section 5. That it is further resolved that the Mayor of the City is herewith directed and authorized to execute on behalf of the City of El Paso de Robles any and all documents necessary for the application and obtaining of a Federal Construction Grant under 33 U.S.C. 466, et seq. (Public Law 660).
