

RESOLUTION NO. 1454

RESOLUTION REGARDING FREEWAY SIGNING

WHEREAS, a joint study has been recently completed by the Planning Commission and the Chamber of Commerce of the City of El Paso de Robles regarding the inadequacies of proper signing of the location and distance of the City of El Paso de Robles, both insofar as U.S. Highway 101 and California State Sign Route 46 are concerned, and

WHEREAS, at a joint meeting of the Planning Commission, the Chamber of Commerce and the City Council of this City such inadequacies were presented by color pictures, together with suggestions for remedial action to be taken by the State Division of Highways, in conformity with existing policy of said State Agency; and

WHEREAS, a written brochure recommending sign improvements has been examined by this City Council and has been delivered to District V of the Division of Highways of the State of California,

BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles as follows:


1) That the above referred to study of signing along the State Highways shows that it is very difficult for members of the travelling public to locate this City, without reference to maps.

2) That this City strongly supports the written recommendations, presented to the Division of Highways, together with typical pictures of highway signs, and recommendation for improvement of the entire signing system insofar as identifying the City of El Paso de Robles is concerned.
