RESOLUTION REGARDING UNDERGROUNDING OF UTILITY
CONNECTIONS FOR BANK OF AMERICA BUILDING

WHEREAS, the Bank of America is finalizing its plans for the construction of a new building at 13th and Spring Streets in the City of El Paso de Robles; and

WHEREAS, the Bank has applied for an encroachment permit to allow the construction of overhangs of approximately six feet over the public sidewalk area on 13th Street adjacent to the building site; and


WHEREAS, such encroachment has been granted subject to the applicant making satisfactory arrangements with the Pacific Telephone Company, which maintains poles in said area, it being understood that the encroachment necessitates the relocation of such poles; and

WHEREAS, it would be desirable to have such utility wires placed underground.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The requested encroachment permit is granted upon the above condition.
2. The City Council encourages the Bank of America to consider having the Pacific Telephone lines placed underground on the 13th Street side of the new Bank premises.
