RESOLUTION NO. 1660

WHEREAS, a general municipal election was held and conducted in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, on Tuesday, the 11th day of April, 1972; and:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles are in session at their regular place this 18th day of April, 1972, pursuant to the Election Code of the State of California, under Section 18400, 18415, 22932, 22933 and 22934; and

WHEREAS, said election was held and conducted in said City at the time and in the manner provided by law and that there were three voting precincts established for the holding of said election, one of which was designated as Precinct "A" comprised of the regular election precincts established for the holding of general County and State elections and known as Paso Robles No. 1; Paso Robles No. 2; Paso Robles No. 3; Paso Robles No. 4; and Paso Robles No. 5. One of which was designated as Precinct "B" comprised of the regular election precincts established for the holding of County and State elections and known as Paso Robles No.6; Paso Robles No. 7; Paso Robles No. 8; Paso Robles No. 10 and Paso Robles No. 11. One of which was designated as Precinct "C" of the regular election precincts established for the holding of County and State elections and known as Paso Robles No. 9; Paso Robles No. 12; Paso Robles No. 13; Paso Robles No. 14 and Paso Robles No. 15; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles having at this meeting canvassed the returns of said election and found that the number of votes cast in said City, the names of the persons voted for, the office for which each person was voted for, the votes given for and against each ballot measure, the number of votes given at each precinct to each person and for and against each ballot measure and the results to be as hereinafter stated:

That the number of votes cast in said election was 1566;
