

RESOLUTION NO. 1674

A RESOLUTION CLOSING A PORTION OF
AN ALLEY IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, having on the 19th day of June, 1972, passed a Resolution of Intention to vacate and close a portion of a street in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, which are more particularly described as follows:

All of that certain portion of the alley that lies between Lot 27, Lot 28 and a portion of Lot 29 as said alley and Lots are shown on the "D.S. Gregory's Subdivision of Riverside Farm No. 2", map filed for record May 8, 1888 in Map Book "B", Page 17 in the office of the County Recorder of San Luis Obispo County, State of California.

WHEREAS, it now appears that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles did cause said Resolution of Intention to be published in the Paso Robles Press as required by law; and

WHEREAS, it also appears that the Director of Public Works for the City of El Paso de Robles did cause notices to be posted along said streets as required by law; and

WHEREAS, it appears further that said notices and publications were in all respects as required by the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of California entitled "Street Vacation Act of 1941", Division IX, Part 3, Chapters 1 and 2 of the Street and Highway Code; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on said proposed closings as so noticed and having heard all evidence offered by any interested persons, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles finds that the street as described is unnecessary for present and prospective future public street purposes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the public alley easement cease on said alley hereinbefore described and be vacated for public street purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California.
