RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING THE ELEVEN ISRAELI
ATHLETES WHO DIED DURING THE XX OLYMPIAD

WHEREAS, in Munich, Germany, the scene of the XX Olympic Games, a tragic incident has occurred taking the lives of eleven athletes who were competing in the Olympic Games, and;

WHEREAS, the Olympic peace was broken by an act of terror committed by a group of extremists, and;


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, along with the rest of the World, expresses a sense of deep outrage and is profoundly distressed by these acts perpetrated against a peaceful occasion, and;

WHEREAS, if allowed to happen again, these incidents would threaten the future of Olympic Games.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles unanimously and sorrowfully pass this Resolution in memory of those who died in Munich, Germany, during the XX Olympiad and extend to all persons whom this tragedy touched, our deepest sympathy.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be sent to the International Olympic Committee.
