

RESOLUTION NO. 1686

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ESTABLISH
A PARKING AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA

WHEREAS, Streets and Highways Code Section 36020, et seq. authorizes the formation of a parking and business improvement area; and

WHEREAS, a proposal for the formation of a parking and business improvement area has been submitted to the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles hereby adopts this Resolution of Intention to Establish a Parking and Business Improvement Area generally described as follows:

That area bounded by 12th Street from Pine Street to the alley easterly of Vine Street; Pine Street from 12th Street to 14th Street; 14th Street from Pine Street to Spring Street; Spring Street from 14th Street to 12th Street.


For the purposes of this Resolution, said area includes all businesses and occupations, whether within a building or not, on both sides and within the above named streets. Said area is more particularly described on a map entitled PASO ROBLES PARKING AND IMPROVEMENT AREA marked "Exhibit A" and attached hereto.

The City Council will consider the establishing of said proposed parking and business improvement area on October 24, 1972, at the hour of 8:00 P.M. in the City Council Chambers, 1030 Spring Street, Paso Robles, California.


The revenue received pursuant to the formation of

said parking and business improvement area will be used for decoration of public places in the area, the acquisition, construction and maintenance of parking facilities for the benefit of the area including center street parking, for the general promotion of retail trade activities in the area and for no other purposes. A fifty percent (50%) increase in the existing business license tax is proposed as a source of revenue, and in addition, each business operating within the area which is exempt from the General Business License Tax will be assessed a levy of \$ 67.50 per year.
