

RESOLUTION NO. 2629

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING  
PROTESTS IN RELATION TO APROPOSED ACQUISITIONS AND  
IMPROVEMENTS, AND DIRECTING NOTICE

36TH, PARK AND SPRING STREETS ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of El Paso de  
Robles, California, that

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution of Intention No. 2625,  
adopted on September 15, 1981, by the City Council, pursuant  
to the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913, as amended, the Engineer  
of Work of said City has filed with the City Clerk the written  
report called for under said Act and by said Resolution of Inten-  
tion which report has been presented by said Engineer of Work to  
this Council for consideration, and this Council has considered  
and preliminarily approved and confirmed said report and ordered  
that the same stand as the report for the purpose of all subsequent  
proceedings had pursuant to said Resolution of Intention.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that October 20,  
19 81, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M., in the regular meet-  
ing place of said Council, City Hall, 1030 Spring Street, Paso  
Robles, California, be, and the same are hereby appointed and fixed  
as the time and place when and where it will consider and finally  
act upon the Engineer's Report under said Resolution of Intention.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk is hereby, directed  
to give notice of said hearing once a week for two weeks in the  
local newspaper published and circulated in said City, and by con-  
spicuously posting a notice thereof along all the open streets  
within the assessment district at not more than three hundred feet  
apart, and not less than three in all; said posting and first pub-  
lication to be had and completed at least twenty (20) days before  
the date herein set for hearing of protests.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said notices shall be headed "Notice of Improvement" in letters of not less than one inch in height and shall, in legible characters, state the fact and date of the passage of said Resolution of Intention and of the filing of said report and of the date, hour and place set for the hearing of said protests, and briefly describe the acquisitions and improvements proposed to be made, and refer to said Resolution of Intention and report for further particulars.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk shall mail or cause to be mailed notice of the adoption of said Resolution of Intention and of the filing of said report, postage prepaid, at least twenty days before the date set for hearing of said protests, to all persons owning real property to be assessed, whose name and addresses appear on the last equalized assessment roll for City taxes prior theret or as known to the Clerk, which notice shall contain a statement of the time, place and purpose of the hearing on said Resolution of Intention and report and a statement of the total estimated cost of said proposed acquisitions and improvements, the amount as shown by said report to be assessed against the particular parcel covered by the notice, together with a statement that any person interested may file a protest in writing as provided in said Act.
