A RESOLUTION ORDERING CHANGES AND MODIFICATIONS

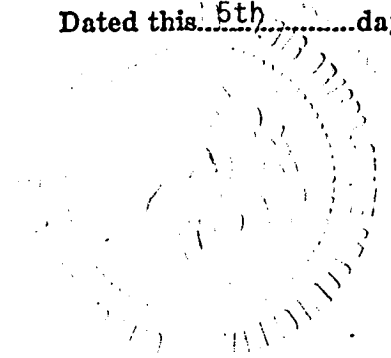
