RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY FOR CONDEMNATION
LOT LOCATED AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF 24TH STREETS
BEING A PORTION OF LOT 7, BLOCK 218, CITY OF EL PASO DE
ROBLES, APN 08-091-21, SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, San Luis Obispo County, California, RESOLVES THAT:

It finds and determines and hereby declares that the public interest and necessity require the acquisition of a water tank site and in connection therewith and necessary therefor, the acquisition of interests in the real property described as a portion of Lot 7, Block 218, City of El Paso de Robles, Assessor's Parcel 08-091-21, being property located at the northeast corner of 24th and Glencrest Streets, in the northerly section of Paso Robles. The property described in this Resolution is necessary for the proposed water tank. The following statutes authorize acquisition of said property by the City of El Paso de Robles: Government Code Section 39792 and Code of Civil Procedure Sections 1230.010 through 1250.370.

Said proposed public improvement is planned and located in the manner that will be most compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury.

This City Council shall acquire in the name of City the said interests in real property described above, which property is necessary for a water tank site, by purchase of condemnation in accordance with the provisions for eminent domain in the Code of Civil Procedure.

Michael T. LeSage, City Attorney for the City of El Paso de Robles, is hereby authorized and empowered:

To acquire in City's name, by condemnation, the said interests in real property in accordance with the provisions for eminent domain in the Code of Civil Procedure and the Constitution of California; and

To prepare and prosecute in City's name such proceedings in the proper court as are necessary for such acquisition.


