

RESOLUTION NO. 2784

A RESOLUTION INITIATING PROCEEDINGS FOR
ANNEXATION NO. 52 (CAFFREY) AND SETTING HEARING

WHEREAS, by petition to the Local Agency Formation Commission, all of the owners of an uninhabited area adjacent to the boundaries of the City of El Paso de Robles did petition and make application for annexation to this City; and

WHEREAS, said annexation was designated "Annexation No. 52 (Caffrey)" by the Local Agency Formation Commission; and

WHEREAS, LAFCo determined by resolution that said annexation was uninhabited; and

WHEREAS, the reasons for the proposed annexation, as set forth in the petition, was to facilitate development of the property into an urban residential development; and

WHEREAS, LAFCo, in making its determination relative to this annexation by Resolution No. 82-18, approved this annexation subject to the following conditions and terms:

That a revised map and legal description approved by the County Surveyor be submitted to the Executive Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles initiates proceedings to annex Annexation No. 52 (Caffrey) by fixing November 16, 1982 at the hour of 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers, 1030 Spring Street, Paso Robles, California as the date, time and place to hear protests against the annexation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is intructed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission and to all owners of property within the annexation territory and any registered voters residing within the territory advising them that they may file a written protest against the annexation with the City Clerk at any time prior to the conclusion of the City Council's hearing on the proposed annexation.
