CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF THE
PARK DEVELOPMENT FUND #339
FOR THE FISCAL YEARS 1983/1984 and 1984/1985

WHEREAS THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of El Paso de Robles hereby approves a supplemental appropriation of Park Development Fund #339 for the Fiscal Years 1983/1984 and 1984/1985.

1. This appropriation is for an amount not to exceed the cash balance in the fund.
2. This appropriation is developed without function or line item detail and equals \$63,658.00.
3. The managements intent is to use this money for costs associated with construction of Tennis Courts at Sherwood Park and improvements made to Barney Schwartz Park.
4. The City Manager is authorized to transfer appropriations between function and line items as it becomes necessary without further City Council action for all individual transactions under \$10,000.00.



DISCUSSION:

Attached for your review is a copy of the bid results received May 4, 1984. Contractors bidding on this project were given the option of a base bid and two bid alternates. After concurring with Stu Ross, Parks and Recreation Director, Bid Alternate 2 was accepted as the bid alternate.

James Metcalf Tennis Court Construction was the low bidder at \$53,350.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council award the Sherwood Tennis Court Overlay and Resurfacing project to James Metcalf Tennis Court Construction in the amount of \$53,350.00 and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to sign the contract documents.
