A RESOLUTION CLOSING A STREET (PORTION OF 15TH STREET),
BETWEEN SOUTHERN PACIFIC RAILROAD AND RIVERSIDE AVENUE,
IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, having on the 5th day of March, 1985 passed a Resolution of Intention to close and vacate that portion of 15th Street 80' wide between the easterly right-of-way line of Southern Pacific Railroad and the westerly right-of-way line of Riverside Avenue in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California as recorded in Book A, Page 169 of Maps on file in the County Recorder's Office of said County; and

WHEREAS, it now appears that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles did cause said Resolution of Intention to be published in the Paso Robles Daily Press as required by law; and

WHEREAS, it further appears that said notices and publications were in all respects as required by the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of California entitled "Street Vacation Act of 1941," Division IX, Part 3, Chapters 1 and 2 of the Streets and Highways Code; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on said proposed closing as so noticed and having heard all evidence offered by any person

interested, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles finds that the street as described is unnecessary for present or prospective future public street purposes.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the public street easement cease on said street hereinbefore described and be vacated for public street purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of San Luis Obispo, State of California.


