RESOLUTION NO. 3012

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SEWER RATE INCREASES

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles:

WHEREAS, Section 14.16.020 (Section 2, Ordinance No. 292 N.S.) of Chapter 14.16 of the Municipal Code of the City of El Paso de Robles, requires the establishment of sewer service charges and permits the City Council, from time to time, to set the amount of said charges; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2921 initiated a minimum rate charge plus four classes of users: (1) Industrial, (2) Commercial and special Groups, and (3) Residential and (4) users outside the City Limits; and

WHEREAS, the conclusion of the Council's Ad Hoc Committee to review the sewer rates is that a thirty one percent (31%) rate increase is needed, and that the increase shall be spread over three years as follows:

These stipulated rates shall be adjusted annually according to changes in the C.P.I.:

WHEREAS, it is now determined that the minimum rate charge and the rates for the various classes of users are to be charged according to the following amounts:

A. MINIMUM RATE CHARGE:

The minimum charge for classes whose rate is based on usage shall be \$6.90 per month for the first 500 cubic feet of water used per month. All usage over 500 cubic feet per month shall be added at their respective rates. Each dwelling unit included in any such establishment shall

also pay an additional \$6.90 per month.

E. OUTSIDE USERS:

That each premise served, which is located outside the City limits, be charged at the above rates respectively multiplied by the factor two (2).

and;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2967 A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SEWER RATES FOR THE PASO ROBLES MOTEL INDUSTRY states that the rates to be charged for the motels in Paso Robles shall be at 75% of the then commercial rates for the 85/86 period and at 100% of the then commercial rates for the 86/87 period, which equals:

Flat Rate	6.90 X .75	= 5.17
Variable Rate	.70 X .75	= .52

WHEREAS, all billing as provided herein is to be computed and billed on a bi-monthly basis for both consumption and flat rate charges; and

WHEREAS, the rates established herein are applicable to all metered and flat rate accounts unless a written agreement is entered into between the party affected and the city of El Paso de Robles concerning special rates or conditions of service where such special rates and conditions are justified; and

WHEREAS, fees specified herein shall be adjusted annually based upon the upward or downward movement of the Consumer's Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers, San Francisco - Oakland, California, all items - Series A (1967=100) (index) published by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics for any change above or below the March 1, 1985, figure. In the event the foregoing index is no longer published, a comparable index will be used; and

WHEREAS, a detailed cost/revenue analysis must be made for fiscal year 1987/1988 to adjust the rates upward or downward as reflected in the analysis; and

WHEREAS, the above rates shall be charged to each user to recover the sum of total capital cost, interest cost, operations and maintenance, depreciation, and general administration and accounting costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that the above listed sewer service charge rates, and adjustments to these rates made in accordance with changes in the CPI as herein specified, be adopted to be effective July 1, 1985.
