

# City of El Paso de Robles

A RESOLUTION NO. 3042  
OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES  
OPPOSING THE DELAY AND/OR ELIMINATION OF NEW FACILITIES,  
REHABILITATION AND OPERATIONAL HIGHWAY PROJECTS  
WITHIN BOTH SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY AND  
THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES CURRENTLY APPROVED  
IN THE STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the State of California has identified significant revenue shortfalls which may cause a delay and/or elimination of currently approved State highway projects within both San Luis Obispo County and the City of El Paso de Robles; and,

WHEREAS, San Luis Obispo county is an under-funded deficit county that is not receiving its designated share of State highway improvements as required by Section 188.8 of the Streets and Highway Codes; and,

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles recognizes the seriousness of the state and federal funding shortfalls and acknowledges the need to share the burden of some project delays; and,

WHEREAS, San Luis Obispo County, a deficit county with 3% of the State Transportation Improvement Program, is being asked to defer \$18.2 million in State highway projects or 6% of all proposed projects and deferrals; and,

WHEREAS, all New Facility Rehabilitation and Operational Improvement State highway projects within San Luis Obispo County currently approved by the California Transportation Commission as part of the five-year STIP are deemed essential for the public safety and welfare of residents and visitors to San Luis Obispo County and the City of El Paso de Robles; and,

WHEREAS, such highway projects, if not undertaken as currently scheduled in the five-year State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), may cause further injuries, damages and inconveniences to the traveling public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles to oppose any delay, elimination or significant modification of these highway projects currently scheduled within the current STIP; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles hereby recommends that the San Luis Obispo Area Coordinating Council encourage the California Transportation Commission to:

1. Reconsider the extent of proposed delays in San Luis Obispo county to more closely approximate its share of the State Transportation Improvement Program; and

2. Retain on schedule all projects budgeted in fiscal years 1985/1986 as recommended by the California Department of Transportation.




