RESOLUTION NO. 3064

## A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING BULK WATER UTILITY RATES FOR HYDRANT METERS AND LOAD COUNTS 1986

BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles:

WHEREAS, Section 14.04.020 of the Municipal Code of the City of El Paso de Robles requires the City Council, from time to time, with references to said section, set fees for bulk water service rates; and

WHEREAS, it is prudent to increase the existing bulk water charges for water used and services rendered to permit the Water Department to operate in a self sustaining manner; and

WHEREAS, it is now determined that the bulk water be charged as follows:

1. That the sale of bulk water from the city's bulk outlet shall be at the rate of \$2.00 per load.
2. That the sale of bulk water from a connection to a fire hydrant be charged at the rate of \$0.67 cents per 100 cubic feet and a rental fee for said hydrant meter be charged at \$30.00 per month or fraction thereof, and that for the relocation of said hydrant meter for the same user, there will be a \$20.00 charge each time the hydrant meter is moved, and that there will continue to be a \$400.00 deposit collected by the City before the hydrant meter is issued.
3. That fees specified herein shall be adjusted annually based upon the upward or downward movement of the Consumer's Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers, San Francisco-Oakland, California, all items - Series A (1967 - 100) (index) published by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Vital Statistics for any change above or below the August 1, 1986, figure. In the event the foregoing index is no longer published, a comparable index will be used. Final approval of any increase pursuant to the Consumer's Price Index shall be subject to council approval.


