

RESOLUTION NO. 87-57

A RESOLUTION VACATING A PORTION OF
LELAND STREET IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES

WHEREAS, the the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, having on the 21st day of July, 1987, passed a Resolution of Intention to vacate a portion of a public street in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, and more particularly described as follows:

The westerly half (20 feet) of Leland Street, between Blackburn and James Streets.

WHEREAS, it now appears that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles did cause said Resolution of Intention to be published in the Country News as required by law; and

WHEREAS, if futher appears that said notices and publications were in all respects completed as required by the provisions of an act of Legislature of the State of California entitled "Street Vacation Act of 1941", Division IX, Part 3, Chapters 1 and 2 of the Streets and Highways Codes; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on said proposed vacation as so noticed and having heard all evidence offered by any person interested, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles finds that the street as described is unnecessary for present or prospective future public street purposes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the public street easement cease on said street herein before described and be vacated for public street purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of San Luis Obispo County, State of California.
