WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, having
on the 15th day of September, 1987, passed a Resolution of Intention to vacate
a portion of public street in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San
Luis Obispo, State of California, and more particularly described as follows:

The easterly half (20 feet) of Leland Street, between
Blackburn and James Streets.

WHEREAS, it now appears that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso
de Robles did cause said Resolution of Intention to be published in the
Country News as required by law; and

WHEREAS, it now appears that said notices and publications were in
all respects completed as required by the provisions of an act of Legislature
of the State of California entitled "Street Vacation Act of 1941", Division
IX, Part 3, Chapters 1 and 2 of the Streets and Highways Codes; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on said proposed vacation as
so noticed and having heard all evidence offered by any person interested, the
City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles find that the street as
described is unnecessary for present and prospective future public street
purposes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the public street easement cease on
said street herein before described and be vacated for public street purposes.

The CITY COUNCIL of the City of EL PASO DE ROBLES does hereby resolve as follows:

1. That it is the intention of the City Council to close and vacate a public street in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, and more particularly described as follows:

The easterly half (20 feet) of Leland Street, between Blackburn and James streets.

2. For further particulars as to the proposed vacation, reference is hereby made to a map now on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles;

3. That Tuesday, October 20, 1987, at the hour of 7:30 p.m. on said date in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 1020 Spring street, Paso Robles, California, is the time and place set forth for hearing all persons interested in or having objections to the proposed closing;

4. That the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles be and is hereby directed to cause a copy of this Resolution of Intention to be published fifteen (15) days prior to the date set herein for hearing in the Country News, a newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of El Paso de Robles, California.

5. The City Engineer of the City of El Paso de Robles be and is hereby directed to cause a notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention and the time and place set for hearing thereon by conspicuously posting notices thereof along the line of the street proposed to be closed.
