POLICIES & PROCEDURES

SUBJECT: AIRPORT DEVELOPMENT POLICY

PURPOSE:

To set forth policies of the City Council with regards to development at the Paso Robles Airport during the development of an Airport Master Plan.

POLICY:

1. PARCELS WITH APPROVED AND/OR EXECUTED LEASES:

The Council will accept requests for authorization to allow development related applications by current lease holders.

2. PARCELS WITH NO LEASE BUT WITH CURRENT APPLICATIONS FOR DEVELOPMENT OR APPROVED DEVELOPMENT PLAN:

The Council will allow consideration and processing of these development applications. Leases will be developed by staff for Council consideration following approval of development plans.

3. PARCELS WITHOUT AN APPROVED AND/OR EXECUTED LEASE AND WITHOUT A CURRENT APPLICATION FOR DEVELOPMENT OR APPROVED DEVELOPMENT PLAN:

The Council will not accept, review or comment on requests for authorization to allow development related applications prior to the acceptance of a revised Airport Master Plan.

PROCEDURE:

1. Staff is directed to present to the Council for their consideration requests for authorization to allow application for development activity on Airport Industrial Park parcels with existing leases.

2. Staff is directed to continue processing of development applications currently in process.

3. Staff is directed not to accept requests for authorization to allow development related applications prior to the acceptance of a revised Airport Master Plan on parcels without leases or active applications.
