SPECIAL COVENANTS OR REMARKS

- 1. All maintenance, involving the physical condition and the operation of the improvements, referred to in Article VI MAINTENANCE of the aforementioned Master Agreement will be performed by the Local Agency and/or the respective agencies as determined by agreement at regular intervals or as required for efficient operation of the completed improvements.
- 2. The Local Agency will advertise, award, and administer this project and will obtain the State's concurrence prior to either award or rejection of the contract.
- 3. The Local Agency agrees the payment of Federal funds will be limited to the amounts approved by the Federal Highway Administration in the Federal-Aid Project Agreement (PR-2)/Detail Estimate, or its modification (PR-2A) or the FNM-76, and accepts any increases in Local Agency Funds as shown on the Finance or Bid Letter or its modification as prepared by the Division of Local Streets and Roads.
- 4. Construction will be programmed as a separate program under Combined Road Plan procedures.
- 5. In executing this Program Supplemental Agreement, Local Agency hereby reaffirms the 'Nondiscrimination Assurances' contained in the aforementioned Master Agreement for Federal-Aid Program.
- 6. Whenever the local agency uses Federal or State Funds to pay a consultant on a cost plus basis, the local agency is required to submit a post audit report covering the allowability of cost payments for each individual consultant or sub-contractor incurring over \$25,000 on the project. The audit report must state the applicable cost principles utilized by the auditor in determining allowable costs as referenced in CFR 48, part 31, Contract Cost Principles.
